We will maintain a clean and safe environment and continue to comply with OSHA and CDC infection control guidelines:

- We sterilize or safely dispose of all instruments and products used during patient care
- All patient care staff are required to wear gloves, face masks and safety glasses
- The dental chair and instrument trays are wiped down with hospital-grade *Cavicide* disinfectant after each patient use
- We have standard protocols in place to disinfect all patient contact areas
- We have expanded and increased the frequency of cleaning and disinfecting all common areas_(countertops, door handles, remote controls, arm-rests) throughout the day
- The fabric chairs will be sprayed with hypoallergenic disinfectants
- We have temporarily removed items that pose a risk for cross-contamination (Magazines newspapers, toys and books)
- Our office has a spacious waiting area and all operatories are separated by physical walls that provide extra protection

To safeguard the health of our staff and our patients, we strongly encourage anyone who has traveled outside of the United States **within the past 14 days** or who is experiencing flu-like symptoms (fever, cough, body aches, severe headaches) to cancel and reschedule appointments.
